## **MEN'S GOLF LEAGUE 2022 VERSION**

At the Captain's meeting on May 12, there was a good discussion about how the Men's Golf League should proceed in 2022. For obvious reasons in 2022, there is less interest in the league and there will be less participation. Several captains are having difficulty filling out their teams and this would impair their ability to compete as a team. So, it was decided to change the league competition this year to individual competition, rather than team competition. Most of the rest of the league will function the same as before.

Team Rosters will still be submitted by the captains, and are due by May 19.

The \$50 entry fee (increased from \$47 at the banquet last year in order to provide more money for the banquet expense) will be collected from members by the captains. Handicaps will be maintained as before. The first league match is June 2 and the last match is August 25 (13 weeks of matches); rainouts will not be made up.

Competition is individual, not team based. Each individual may play in the league as many Thursdays as they like (a maximum of 13), but must play at least 4 times, in order to be eligible for a cash prize at the banquet, which will be on September 8. Individuals should try to play more than 4 times in order to allow for rainouts. Competition is handicapped (based on net score). At the end of the season, each individual's best 4 scores will be ranked to determine who wins a cash prize. The number of payouts will be determined when we know how much money we have for the purse. Individuals who play less than 4 times are not eligible for a cash prize at season end.

Sand trap relief (players choice): rake and place or take relief outside of and behind the trap keeping it between the hole and the ball.

Green relief from damaged spots: to avoid putting over a damaged / under repair spot, move the ball to the left or the right no more than 1 club length and no closer to the hole, subject to the approval of your playing group.

Each week, foursomes will be determined based on a random draw.

The Hole-in-One contest is active and the current prize is \$1,965. You cannot win the contest without paying your \$2 yearly update fee or the \$10 fee for new members.
